



All pets staying in Berlin must be registered with the official veterinarian (Amtstierarzt). The Berlin Senate covers the costs of the "arrival package" for pets from Ukraine.

Arrival package includes

- rabies vaccination/ antibody test
- microchip implantation and official medical registration
- issuance EU pet passport
